

The Keating Township Supervisors met on February 17, 2021 at 5:00 pm in the Township Building with Chairman McClain bringing the meeting to order and leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Wheeler, Supervisor Covert, Secretary Bowser and two (2) township residents attended the meeting.

PUBLIC HEARD:

There was no public heard.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1) A motion was made by Supervisor Wheeler/2nd Covert to announce the hiring of a Sewer Operator. Motion carried unanimously with Supervisor McClain recusing himself.
- 2) A motion was made by Supervisor McClain/2nd Wheeler to advertise Ordinance 105: ATV ordinance. Motion carried with 2 for and 1 against. Supervisor Covert also wanted it to go on record that “I think it is a horrible mistake and that I hope that everyone can live with it when the first person gets killed.”
- 3) A motion was made by Supervisor McClain/2nd Wheeler to set up UPMC and Highmark on autopay if there are no fees. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4) A motion was made by supervisor McClain/2nd Wheeler to pay the invoice to Covert Power and Controls, LLC for the shop lights. Motion carried unanimously with Supervisor Covert abstaining due to conflict of interest.
- 5) A motion was made by Supervisor Covert/2nd McClain to allow Kronenwetter a 30-day extension on Contract 1C if it is a No Cost Change Order. Motion carried unanimously.
- 6) Supervisor Covert explained where the valves are going to be at the new sewer plant and that he was going to send an email to the engineering to see if there is a way to put the valves where the operator could operate it.
- 7) A motion was made by Supervisor McClain/2nd Wheeler to move to cellular dialers at the new pump stations instead of using Verizon. Supervisor Covert is sending an email to the engineers to let know of our plans. Motion carried unanimously.
- 8) Supervisor Covert would like to see a town hall meeting before doing the contractor training to get a lot of the questions and answers out of the way by the constituents. Discussion was made to see if able to video the town hall meeting and the training to place on the website for information purposes only.
